If your cat is missing, immediately contact the Floodwood Police Department at 218.476.2239, leaving a description of the animal.

If your cat is found by the Floodwood Police Department you may be subject to penalties under the City of Floodwood Cat Ordinance. If your cat has a tag on its collar, we will make every attempt to contact you. We also post notices on Facebook of cats found. If we cannot contact you, your cat will be taken to an animal shelter where it will be held per their policies.

Before the animal shelter will release your cat, you must obtain a release certificate from the City of Floodwood and present the certificate to the shelter. The shelter will require all their fees to be paid before they release your cat to you.
