## Campground Rules

- One (1) unit per site.
- Speed Limit 5 mph.
- No burning garbage in fire pits.
- Please leave the campsite CLEANER than you found it!
- Pets allowed but must be on leash at all times. Clean up after your pets.
- No dumping of garbage in the river.
- Quiet hours 10:00 PM – 7:00 AM
- Do not discharge 'grey' water onto the ground.
- Do not dump garbage in shower house garbage cans.

## Guidelines for Visitors

---

When camping, visitors should follow these recommendations:

**Plan ahead.** When you are able, make reservations and payments online at [www.ci.floodwood.mn.us](http://www.ci.floodwood.mn.us) Visit Floodwood – Municipal Campground – Follow the Hip Camp Link.

**Be self-sufficient.** Be prepared to be self-contained and self-sufficient as possible. For example, arrive prepared with own soap, surface disinfectant, supplies, hand sanitizer, paper towels/hand towels and toilet paper just to be sure.

**Socially distance yourself.** To ensure that social distancing can be maintained, it is best to set up your campsite-sleeping, campfire and eating areas – to maximize distance from adjacent campsites that host people from different households.

**Recreate with your household.** Restrict use of your individual campsite/campfire to only those in your immediate household.

**Know before you go.** Be prepared for lower levels of service and public contact.

**Follow the rules.** Follow all campground rules and instructions, whether given in writing or verbally, that protect your safety and the safety of others. These rules and instructions will likely include facility-specific direction about things such as:

- Wearing face masks in public settings, such as within the bathroom.
- Leave picnic tables where you found them
- Restrict use of your campsite/campfire to only those in your immediate household
- Follow signage such as waiting your turn and capacity limits

## Handwashing

---

Visitors and employees are reminded to wash their hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water frequently throughout the day. The City of Floodwood will provide handwashing supplies in the restrooms. Should those supplies become depleted please message the campground host at 612-616-1391



## Single Household Sites

---

Individual campsites are to be used only by members of the same household. Only one camping unit (tent, camper, etc.) is allowed per site.

Visitors will be required to park their camping unit 30 feet from other camping units.

## Social distancing

---

Employees of the City of Floodwood Campground will maintain six feet of distance from all visitors.

Visitors of the City of Floodwood Campground will maintain six feet of distance from all other non-household visitors.

## Shower House /Bathroom Housekeeping

- One person at a time unless from the same household.
- The City of Floodwood Campground practices cleaning protocols based on the MDH and CDC guidelines.
- Restroom and shower house will be open to registered guests only.
- Restroom and shower house will be cleaned 2 times a day or more.
